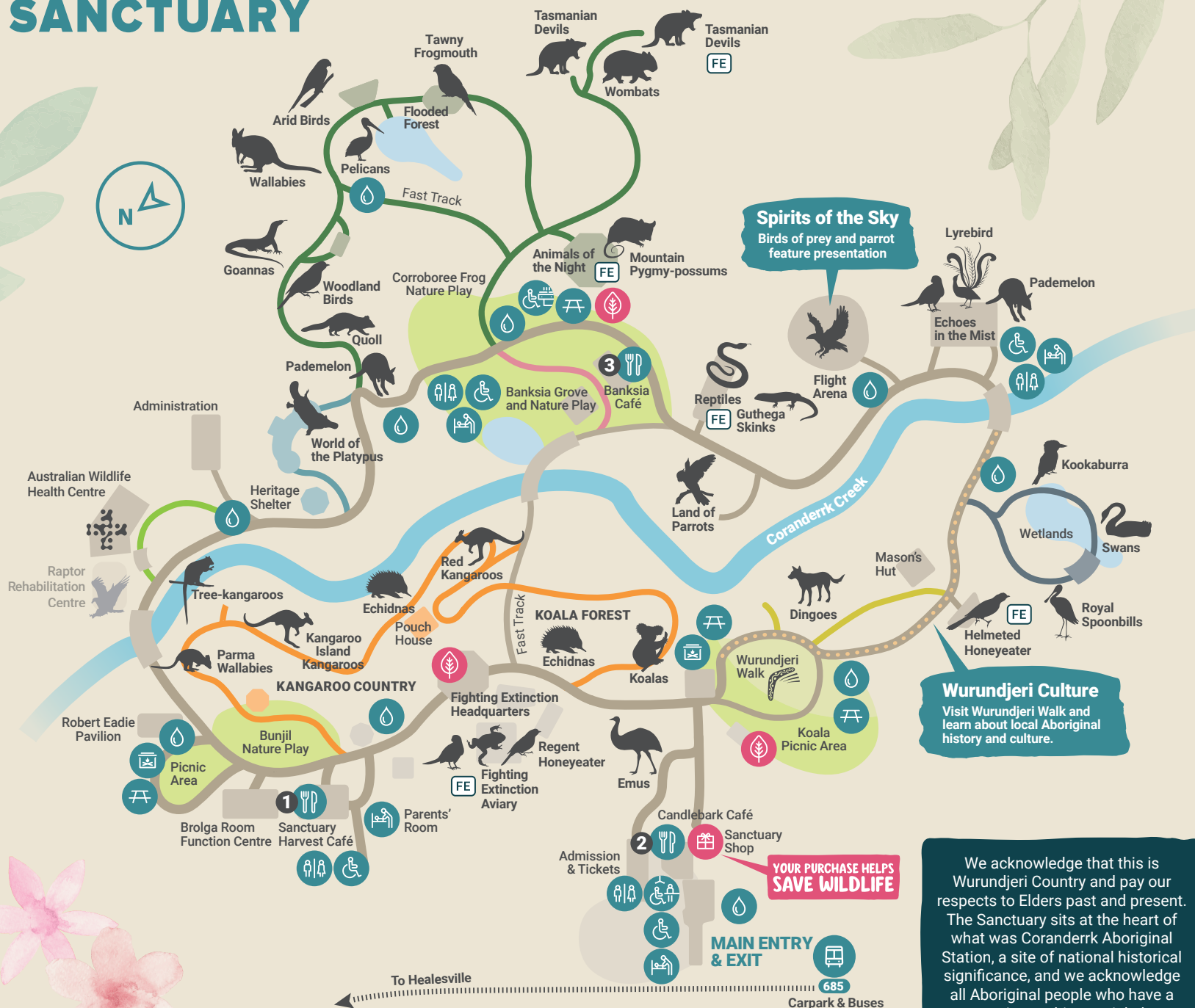


# Welcome
